IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ELIGIBLE CATHOLIC RATEPAYERS



Catholic education has been an integral part of Ontario's history for more than 160 years. As a vital component of the province's publicly funded education system, Catholic schools educate nearly 600,000 students each year. Did you know that your school support defaults to English Public each time you move residences? You must re-declare yourself as English Separate. It is important to regularly verify your tax-directed support by checking your property tax bill or speaking to your landlord. You may also call the Municipal Property Assessment Office at 1-866-296-6722. By ensuring that you are registered as a separate school supporter, you are helping to deliver a powerful message to the Ontario government about the level of support for publicly funded Catholic education in your district.

Toonies for Terry

This year marks the 40th anniversary of the Terry Fox Run to raise funds for cancer research. Terry Fox showed us that anything is possible if we try and reminded us that we can make a difference in the world. St. Francis will celebrate Terry Fox's legacy on October 7th (rain date: October 8th). To ensure that our cohorts practice physical distancing, our run will look different this year but our goal will remain the same: to raise awareness and funds for cancer research.

Rather than run as a whole school, our students will complete the run/walk around the school yard in their cohorts at various points throughout the day.

Discussions will be held in classrooms about cancer awareness and Terry's important lessons about empathy, understanding, community, healthy living and gratitude. Students who own Terry Fox t-shirts are encouraged to wear them on October 7th. Families who are able to contribute are asked to make a minimum \$2 donation toward cancer research by sending it in a sealed plastic bag by October 7th.
